DEMONSTRATION OF FREEDOM

INTENTION Your project consists in doing research on a **historical event** that highlights a **demonstration of freedom**. You will need to describe the historical event to demonstrate how it represents the concept of freedom and engage in **dialogue** with your peers.

IMPORTANT DETAILS

For a well completed project, you will need to follow the instructions below :

- Pick a historical event that demonstrates freedom
 - A list of events will be provided
- Do some research on the assigned event
 - Try to gather concise information that your peers will easily understand
- Fill in the given table on your research document while doing your research
 - What? Who? Where? When? Why? Describe the event.
 - How? Describe the relation between your event and the concept of freedom
- Engage in a discussion respecting conditions that foster dialogue :
 - Correctly express your ideas
 - Respect the right of others to speak
 - Attentively listen to what another person has to say
 - Respect the rules established in class for engaging in dialogue*
 - Use ways discussed in class of alleviating tensions*
 - Open yourself to different ways of thinking
 - Introduce nuances to your comments and recognize the nuances introduced by others

* Class rules concerning conditions that foster dialogue will be discussed and decided as a group. Everyone will contribute to the rules in order to encourage students to engage in dialogue.
